Application Deadline: 4:00 pm Friday, April 17, 2026

Notification of Recipients: Recipients will be notified in May.

Applicant Eligibility:

- Scholarship is limited to a graduating senior in the Argyle ISD schools.
- Applicant must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 (C) or better.
- Applicant must have completed at least 100 hours of volunteer service during high school.

Volunteer service means service to the community through a non-profit organization.

Volunteer hours may include any work completed as a requirement for school or church.

- A letter(s) from the person(s) supervising the volunteer activities verifying the hours must be included.

Application and Essay Review: Applications are submitted for blind review by a selection committee, which will be the final determinant of the winner.

Note: Application documents cannot be shared links to a google account. Any supporting documents must arrive in a single file and compiled into one email. Your high school counselor must be copied on the applicant submission email.
